Governance

Governance is about taking responsibility for the running of an organisation and doing everything within the law to ensure its success. This requires a multi-disciplinary approach and that is why it is so important for trustees to have a clear understanding of what governance is – and what it is not

Case Study... Cold Barn Farm



We are a newly formed committee who took over the running of Cold Barn Farm in January 2023. TVA (in particular Tom and Clare), have been a great help in getting us up and running and applying for grants. They have provided support and guidance on how to set up events, manage the

building and apply for funding.

We have felt supported and it has enabled us to successfully run a number of events, apply for funding and run a very busy warm hub. In April 2023, we were awarded a one off grant of £3000 from TVA in recognition of all the work we have been doing in the community, as a committee we decided to use this funding towards getting a lifesaving defibrillator which we have attached to the wall outside of the building. This is a huge benefit not only to the centre but to the wider community also. This has been greatly recieved by the public and we are so thankful to TVA for giving us the grant to enable us to offer this.

Opening Doors About the Project Opening Doors CONNECTING TORFAEN

The aim of the Opening Doors Project is to recognise community venues who engage lonely and isolated people and give support to access a range of services including wellbeing. The network encourages the hubs to work together, share information and prevent duplication. The network currently has over 30 hubs across the Torfaen borough

Benefits of the Network

Increased engagement with lonely and isolated people, make connections with other hubs, make links with partners, access to help in promoting heath and wellbeing, assistance to promotion and social media, a range of support from the Opening Doors Officer

Networking Forum

A networking forum is held every quarter at a Opening Doors Hub. The purpose of this event is for a range of speakers to share information on a range of topics as well as representitives from a variety of hubs to share their groups and activities. The event also provides networking opportunities. The next forum will be held in the Autumn. If you would like to attend the next event, contact Caroline.

Connecting Torfaen Grant

A grant up to £2,500 is available to Hubs via an application form. The grant is to help engage more lonely and isolated people, to ensure a welcoming space for the community to connect and access services.

Community Information Folders

These folders are given to Opening Doors Hub to display for the community to easily access the information. They contain a range of information including contact details for Hubs, services, agencies, and organisations. The folder gives information about Food Banks and useful websites

including wellbeing.

Connect Torfaen

The community platform where you can meet friends, make connections and share information

More than 700 people and organisations have signed up to the new website that promotes a variety of events including summer fun for children and families, twilight yoga and social activities such as craft groups and coffee mornings.

An interactive map will let you search for activities and events across your community to keep you in the know of what's on around Torfaen.

You can browse activities and events just by visiting Connect Torfaen <u>here</u>, or sign up as a member and interact with other registered users.

Connect Torfaen is a partnership between Torfaen Voluntary Alliance (TVA), Torfaen Council and the Aneurin Bevan University Health Board.



Cost of Living Support

In response to the cost of living crisis that is affecting all of us, Connect Torfaen, the real social network, has added a new category to the system: Cost of Living / Costau Byw.

This new category will make it easier for people to browse local services that may be able to help them, and for organisations to find sources of support for their clients.

But we need your help.

As Connect Torfaen is a 'self-service' platform, where organisations control their own listings, we ask that if you are registered you take a couple of moments to log in and apply the new category to any applicable services.

If you haven't registered your organisation and services on the platform before, please do so now. It is straight forward, and you can edit your entry as often as you like.

The platform is only useful if people can find the information they need, so we would be grateful if you could review your information and add the new Cost of Living category where it applies.

Mount Pleasant Hall



Mount Pleasant Hall in Pontnewydd, Cwmbran, has reopened under the new management committee - The Family & Community Group!

The Family & Community Group is a registered charity, operated by volunteers to support children, young people and families. The group are working hard to develop the venue, opening up unused parts of the venue to provide support and opportunities, such as developing an IT suite, a sensory room, and a multi-functional area that complements the large hall. The group appreciates the continuing support from their partners, such as local county and community Councillors from the Pontnewydd ward, TVA, and funders investing in the venue and the work of the charity.



The group have successfully secured grants, helping to open up the venue, and developing opportunities. Thanks to the support of volunteers, the venue is now open for occasional use. events such as the fundraiser for the Togs Centre, the Young Carers group accessed two evenings of activities during Carers Week.

There have also been birthday parties and other occasional activities taking place within the community facilities. The venue benefits from a large hall and stage, which is accessible, and in a prime location. there are also two inflatables available in the hall, they are used by groups and enjoyed by children.
